APPLICATION AND INFORMATION: **Students are expected to complete an application** to participate at Ho'olaule'a. The application is available from Mrs. Patrick in the Po'o Kula's office area of the high school campus.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: **Students should complete an application as early as possible**. The deadline to submit an application is 2 weeks prior to the event, Friday, April 6, 2018. Completed application is submitted to Mrs. Patrick

BOOTH INFORMATION: Vendors will be located in the Paki/Konia Vendor Courtyard **and/or** in the Quad. A 10' x 10' booth space is FREE for student vendors/Hō'ike Nui. **Students are expected to provide their own accommodations,** (tent, table, table coverings and chairs).

BOOTH LOCATION: **Students** are assigned a location/spot by the Vendor Chair. These assignments are usually made the week before the event and may not be confirmed until the day of the event. Please arrange for assistance from your 'ohana to help you set up and break down at the end of the event.

SILENT AUCTION DONATIONS (optional): If applicable, you are encouraged to maximize your booth's exposure by donating an item (\$25 minimum value) to the Silent Auction. You may provide information about your project that can be placed next to your donated item referring event participants to your spot in the Vendor Courtyard. Please submit your donation to Mrs. Patrick by April 13, 2018.

SET UP: Vehicles may drive in to drop off goods beginning at 6:00 am. All vehicles must be off of the event location fire lane by 7:30am. Vendor parking will be available in a designated area close to the Vendor Courtyard. Event hours: 9:00 am – 3:30 pm, no early departures allowed. Booth break down to commence between 3:30 pm and 4:00 pm. Students must vacate the Vendor Courtyard and campus by 5:00 pm.
