Out of respect for the safety and well-being of all in attendance, all guests will be required to adhere to the following event guidelines:

- Strollers are permitted on Kōnia Field but may not take up space at a table under the tent. You will be asked to move them outside of the tent to a designated area. Wagons will not be permitted on Kōnia Field.
- Keiki under the age of 5 are welcome to attend Lū'au, but if they do not have a ticket, they must be seated in parent's lap and not take the seat of a paid ticket.
- There will be NO alcohol on campus. Guests who are found with alcohol will be asked to leave.
- Security and/or event staff reserve the right to refuse entry, or ask any guest to leave campus, if they refuse to abide by safety guidelines.
- "Night at Kalauao" After Party guests are welcome to bring a lawn chair. Tents and beach umbrellas will not be permitted.
- There will be an ATM available at Pearl.
