- Student drivers' application for the 2025-2026 school year (copies available at the high school office, Student Activities Center or online at <a href="http://www.ksbe.edu/education/hawaii/high\_school/">http://www.ksbe.edu/education/hawaii/high\_school/</a>).
- Attend a student drivers' orientation. These will be held at the following dates/times:
  - Thursday, July 17th, from 8-9am or 3-4pm via Zoom (meeting link will be forwarded at a later date)
- Provide copies of your current driver's license, vehicle(s) registration, safety check card(s) and liability insurance card(s).
- Payment of \$5.00 for parking permit. (Cash preferred. Checks made payable to Kamehameha Schools)

Student attendance for the orientation session is <u>mandatory</u> for all students wanting to drive to school. Students unable to attend these sessions will not be allowed to drive to school. <u>Previous year's student parking passes are expired and will not be honored. Parent and Staff parking passes will also not be honored for students driving to school.</u>

At these orientations, the Kamehameha Schools Hawai`i's student drivers' manual will be reviewed and intructions on obtaining your student parking permits will be shared.
