IMPORTANT!

For early pick-up or changes to afternoon transportation pick-up, parent <u>MUST</u> call the student's division office in advance.



- Vehicles MUST have designated PICK-UP tag on vehicle, clearly displayed
- Do NOT park or drop off/pick up child in bus area
- DO pick up child no later than
 3:15 pm
- DO use cross-walk when crossing from parking to ramp





- Educate your child about his/her bus route
- Elementary 1:1 Pick-up policy

➤ Bus drivers will ONLY release student to a parent or an authorized adult

 If not picked up, child is returned to school after completion of route

IMPORTANT!


If transportation changes, parent MUST CALL the student's division office by 11:00 am. Notification by a child alone is NOT SUFFICIENT.
