We were notified today that two haumana in Upper Division (grades 6-8) have tested positive for COVID-19. Based on the information we received, we've communicated with all kumu and haumāna that may potentially be a close contact in this case. If you haven't received quarantine instructions from us directly, you have not been impacted.

We all have kuleana to help reduce the spread of this virus in our community. With the number of COVID cases on Maui continuing to fluctuate, we urge kumu, staff and haumāna to get vaccinated and/or participate in our COVIDsurveillance testing.
