- Individuals receiving the vaccination shot will be required to stay for a

15 to 30-minute observation period after receiving the shot.

- All registrants must bring the following to the appointment:
- Parent/guardian picture ID
- Registration confirmation email or text
- A copy of your medical insurance card.
- For any questions regarding vaccines, please contact your personal physician.
