What to know before making your appointment:

- Individuals under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- We will be administering the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine which requires two doses (21 days apart) for full vaccination. Your appointment for the second dose will be scheduled when you arrive for your first dose appointment.
- Individuals receiving the vaccination shot will be required to stay for a 15 to 30-minute observation period after receiving the shot.
- All registrants must bring the following to the appointment:
 - Parent/guardian picture ID
 - Registration confirmation email or text
 - A copy of your medical insurance card.

For any questions regarding vaccines, please contact your personal physician.
