We were notified today that one haumana in Upper Division (grades 9-12) and one staff member have tested positive for COVID-19. Based on the information we received, we've communicated with all kumu and haumāna that may potentially be a close contact in these cases. If you haven't received quarantine instructions from us directly, you have not been impacted.

We all have kuleana to help reduce the spread of this virus in our community. With the number of COVID cases on Maui continuing to fluctuate, we urge kumu, staff and haumāna to get vaccinated and/or participate in our COVID surveillance testing.
