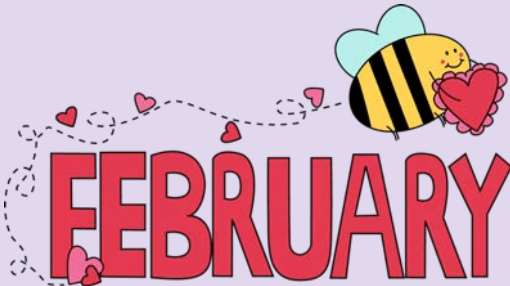

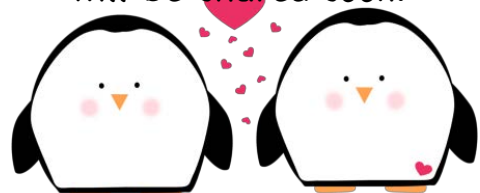
## ALL SCHOOL MOVIE NIGHT

Hall**

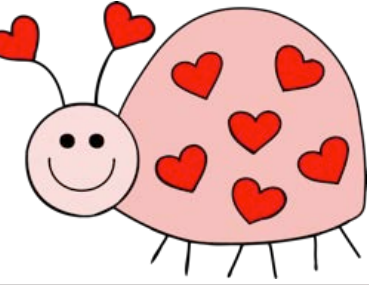

homeroom kumu; a lei-a-day.

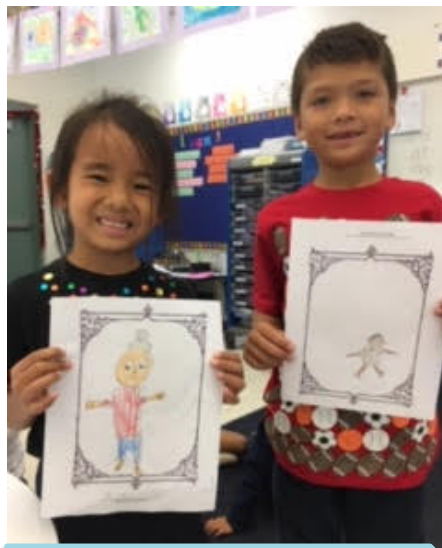
We will designate a day for each of the

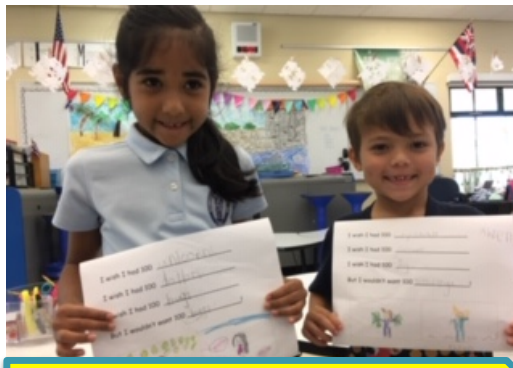
