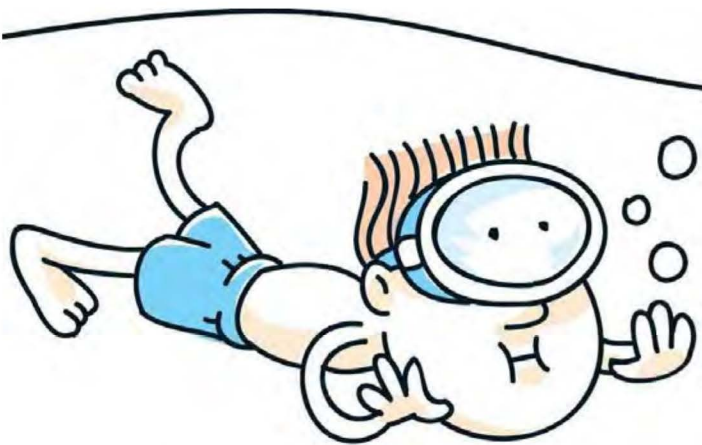


Swim Schedule
