Aloha e nā mākua,

We are hoping for and planning toward a return to normalcy next school year. That means it's medical clearance time again! Medical clearance will continue to be processed through the Electronic Health Record (EHR) portal, Moʻomōʻali Olakino. To access the EHR portal, please login using your KS Account at https://ohana.ksbe.edu. All documentation should be uploaded through the EHR portal as a document or image. Medical clearance re-enrollment will open on April 1, 2023; please complete all requirements by June 1, 2023.

Every student will need to have their health summary completed through the EHR portal. All information entered last year has been saved for your review. Please ensure the accuracy of the information and make changes as necessary to medical conditions, medications, and allergies. Even if there are no changes, you will still need to complete this step.

A completed KS Physical Evaluation form completed on or after July 1, 2022 is required for <u>SCHOOL</u> clearance for returning students who will be entering grades 3, 5, 7, 9, or 11. Please upload the completed form in the EHR portal as a document or image. In general, whenever your child has a well-child visit with a healthcare provider, we recommend that you have the healthcare provider complete the KS Physical Evaluation form and upload the completed form anytime during the year. When submitting a completed KS Physical Evaluation form, please also submit a current immunization record.

A completed KS Physical Evaluation form is required for <u>SPORTS</u> clearance. If your child is a returning student entering a grade for which a Physical Evaluation form is not required for school clearance, it is still required for sports clearance. A completed KS Physical Evaluation form is required every 13 months for sports clearance. If you are unsure of your child's last physical exam date, you can find the information on the EHR portal.

Please note a change to our KS Physical Evaluation form regarding history of COVID. This is important from a medical perspective so our nurses can care for your child knowing full medical history, but this information is also important for our Athletic Trainers to know so they can help monitor for any potential post-COVID complications that might arise during athletics. If your KS Physical Evaluation form does not have the history of COVID question on the form, you have an outdated version.

For returning students entering grade 7, the Hawai'i Department of Health requires the following immunizations. Returning students entering grade 8 who did not complete these immunizations last year will need to do so.

- Tetanus, Diphtheria and Acellular Pertussis (Tdap);
- Two (2) doses of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV); and
- Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (MCV)

Please upload an immunization record that documents receipt of these immunizations.

For returning students entering grades 9 - 12, we are also requiring the completion of a tuberculosis (TB) risk assessment on the parent portal. TB clearance may be required by colleges and universities for those students who enroll in dual-credit courses. By completing the risk assessment, we may be able to issue the TB clearance to facilitate enrollment into dual-credit courses. If the TB risk assessment is positive, your child will be required to obtain TB clearance from your regular healthcare provider.

If your child will need to take or have available a medication on campus that you would like for KS Health Services staff or their designee to administer, a completed Request for Administration of Medication (RAM) form signed by your child's healthcare provider is required. The parent/guardian can determine if their child can safely self-administer a medication. However, controlled medications (i.e. narcotics and certain ADHD medication) as well as CBD oil are not permitted to be possessed by students and require a RAM. A separate RAM form should be completed for each medication, and the medication must be in its original packaging and not expired. If the prescribed medication, dose, or frequency changes prior to the start of school or during the school year, please submit an updated RAM. Please refer to the Student and Parent Handbook for additional information regarding medication administration.
