

What is it?

The Kūkulu Kumuhana process is a tiered system of student support services. The process moves from the simplest teacher-student interventions (universally available) to more complex support interventions (i.e. strategic and intensive).

Who is involved?

An interdisciplinary Student Success Team (SST) led by different Assistant Principals, K-12.

What is my role?

Kūkulu Kumuhana is a process that is most effective as a partnership between the school and the home. To best serve your keiki, it is crucial that you be a part of the process.

What services are available?

There are approximately 30 types of different supports available to haumāna at KSM.
