Checklist for New Invitees NEW TO School in Hawai'i includes all students entering Kindergarten

KS Account

- Login to KS Account via <http://ohana.ksbe.edu/> and access Mo'omō'ali Olakino (EHR).

By **June 1, 2020**, Complete through the parent portal of Mo'omō'ali Olakino (EHR)

- Complete the Student Health Summary.
- Complete the tuberculosis (TB) risk assessment questionnaire.
- Upload a completed KS Physical Evaluation form with the date of the physical examination on or after July 1, 2019. The KS Physical Evaluation form must be used.
- Upload an immunization record that documents receipt of the required immunizations:

**One dose of MCV administered after age 16 years is required.

- Upload a completed Request for Administration of Medication (RAM) form for each medication ONLY if the medication is to be held in the health room and administered by Health Services staff. Controlled substances including common ADHD medications require a RAM.

Potential Student-Athletes

- Upload a completed KS Physical Evaluation form at least every 13 months. The KS Physical Evaluation form must be used.

If your child is considering participating in any athletic sport(s) during the upcoming school year, a completed KS Physical Evaluation form is required at least every 13 months. However, we are in communication with HHSAA about temporarily changing this or allowing exemptions.
