Checklist for 7th grade students

KS Account

- Login to KS Account via <http://ohana.ksbe.edu/> and access MoŌmŌali Olakino (EHR)

By **June 1, 2020**, Complete through the parent portal of Mo omō ali Olakino (EHR)

- Complete the Student Health Summary.
- Complete the tuberculosis (TB) risk assessment questionnaire.
- Upload a completed KS Physical Evaluation form with the date of the physical examination on or after July 1, 2018. **For students entering 7th grade, the date of the physical exam must be on or after July 1, 2019.**
- Upload a completed Request for Administration of Medication (RAM) form for each medication ONLY if the medication is to be held in the health room and administered by Health Services staff. Controlled substances including common ADHD medications require a RAM.
