**COVID Protocols:**

1. All guests, age 12 years and older, must provide at check-in proof of vaccination or a NEGATIVE COVID test taken within 48 hours of the first event, and matching identification.
  - a. You must be tested with a viral test to look for current infection - these include an antigen test or a nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT).
  - b. You can use a self-test (sometimes referred to as home test) that meets the following criteria:
    - i. The test must be a SARS-CoV-2 viral test (nucleic acid amplification test [NAAT] or antigen test).
    - ii. The testing procedure must include a telehealth service affiliated with the manufacturer of the test that provides real-time supervision remotely through an audio and video connection. Some FDA-authorized self-tests that include a telehealth service may require a prescription.
    - iii. The telehealth provider must confirm your identity, observe the sample collection and testing procedures, confirm the test result, and issue a report.
  - c. A test result must be in the form of written documentation (paper or digital copy). The documentation must include:
    - i. Type of test (indicating it is a NAAT or antigen test)
    - ii. Entity issuing the result (e.g., laboratory, healthcare entity, or telehealth service)
    - iii. Sample collection date
    - iv. A negative test result must show the sample was taken no more than 48 hour prior to event.
    - v. Information that identifies the person (full name plus at least one other identifier such as date of birth)
    - vi. Test result
2. All guests are required to wear a mask indoors, while not actively eating or drinking. While masks are not required outdoors, they are encouraged.

Please keep this information for your records.** You may provide this copy or your original confirmation email at event check-in (check junk mail and/or spam folder). If you are the ticket purchaser and/or not the attendee, or arriving separately, please share this information with your party. Guests whose names are not at check-in may be delayed entry.


**Parking:** Self-parking in lot, or street parking. Parking is limited, guests are encouraged to carpool.
