Hoʻomaikaʻi (Congratulations) on your acceptance into Kamehameha Schools - Kapālama! We are excited to be a part of your High School journey!

In years past, we have called all New Invitees to campus on a Saturday in April to take a Mathematics Placement Test with the goal of placing each student in the appropriate class where the student is (1) challenged, and (2) able to thrive. It is important that both students and parents realize that we are trying to place students where they best fit into our math program at Kamehameha Schools Kapālama.

We realize that asking everybody to come to campus on a Saturday to take a math test is a burden, so in an effort to improve our practices we have made an online version of our math placement test that students can take <u>at home</u>. We are asking for <u>some</u> parent assistance in administering this test. REMEMBER: Your child has already been accepted into Kamehameha Schools! Getting an honest assessment on your child's current math capability will help with appropriate class placement and ultimately benefit your keiki and the school. This test **does not** affect acceptance.
