**Supervision:** Prom Advisors Kaimiloa Yoshida (Class of 2026), Eric Stack and Kehau Kalili (Class of 2027), and Shaun Chillingworth (ASKS); HS Administration Team, Faculty and Staff Chaperones, PTO Volunteer Chaperones, and KSH Security.

**Tickets:** All tickets for the event should be purchased on the [KSH GoFan page](#) by **Friday, March 13, 2026**. Purchasing a ticket is an agreement to abide by all guidelines and expectations of attending this KS-Sponsored, After-Hours Event and submitting all forms on-time.

- An access code is required and will be included in a message to students and 'ohana about prom.
- Tickets are non-transferrable. **Full refunds are available if requested by April 3**. No refunds will be available after this date.
- Juniors and Seniors will not be allowed to switch guests unless approved by Administration. No switching after April 3.
- A refund will be issued if a guest is ineligible to attend.

#### **Special Conditions:**

In completing this permission form, haumāna and 'ohana acknowledge that:

- Check-in starts at 5:45 p.m.; Attendees must arrive by 6:30 p.m. and not depart before 8:30 p.m.
  - **All attendees should have a photo I.D. available at check-in.**
  - If there are extenuating circumstances, a late arrival/early departure may be requested in writing to askshawaii@ksbe.edu. Subject to approval from High School Administration.
  - Anyone not checked in by 6:30 p.m. will have their 'ohana notified.
  - All attendees are required to stay within the boundaries for the event until departure.
- All attendees must be eligible to participate in after-school activities. **Students will be considered ineligible if they are on academic or conduct probation.** HS Administration will communicate to any HS students and parent/guardians if they are ineligible. Ineligible juniors and seniors and/or their guests will be removed from the check-in list and a refund will be processed. Refunds may take up to four (4) weeks following the event.
- All KSH students are required to attend school on Thursday, April 23 unless you have a modified schedule or previous arrangements have been made.
- All attendees agree to complying with KS' wellness policy and to stay home if feeling sick.
- All attendees agree to complying with [the semi-formal dress code requirements](#) for the event as stated on the prom webpage on the Associated Students of Kamehameha Schools Hawai'i website.
- As a Christian school, modesty and behaving respectfully is an expectation. All attendees are required to abide by the Behavioral Expectations for a school event, including refraining from sexually suggestive or violent dancing or behavior.

**Transportation:** All attendees are responsible for providing their own transportation to and from the event venue. The event venue features a considerable amount of available parking on-site, so drop-offs and pick-

ups, as well as parking, will not be an issue.

In providing our own transportation, I/we agree to waive, release and hold harmless the State of Hawai'i, HAIS, and Kamehameha Schools from any responsibility for injuries, liabilities, losses, or damages connected with or arising out of the transportation of my/our child in a vehicle other than a Type I or II school bus.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) agree that -

- I/We will transport my/our child to/from the event venue.
- I/We authorize my/our child who has a valid State of Hawai'i motor vehicle driver's license to transport himself/herself to and from the event venue.
- I/We have designated another adult to transport my/or child to/from the event venue.

If students are driving themselves, and are under 18, we do recommend having parents complete a [Parental Permission Slip for Curfew](#), and have it in the car to be ready per county regulations. Additional information is available on the website.

**Bag Checks:** Small purses are allowed, however are subject to **a screening search** prior to entering the venue. **No bag storage will be available at the event.** Any large bags should be left in a vehicle or at home. Please refrain from bringing valuable or irreplaceable items.

**Visual and/or sound recording:** Prom is a highly documented event and the event will feature a photo booth and other event photography and videography. In signing the form, attendees and their parents/guardians consent to the making of visual and/or sound recordings (materials) of their child by KS. I/We consent to KS' use of the materials in any manner and purpose deemed appropriate by KS. I/We waive any right to approve the materials and I/we understand that KS is not obligated to use any of the materials. I/we have read the information about the KS Hawai'i's Junior/Senior Prom Committees plans for the event as described earlier and in detail on the 2026 Prom webpage. By signing the acknowledgement and permission form for participation, I/we acknowledge that I/we understand and have considered all of the information contained in the form cover and on the Prom webpage.

**Insurance and Release:** If an emergency medical procedure or treatment is required during the event, I/we consent to the supervising adult(s) taking, arranging for, or consenting to the procedure for treatment at his, her or their discretion. I represent that my/our child has insurance through my/our carrier to cover any accidents/injuries sustained to my/our child. In consideration for my/our child's participation in the above scheduled KS event, and on behalf of myself/ourselves, my/our personal representatives, my/our heirs, my/our assignees and my/our child, (a) I/we waive and release any and all claims against KS, and its trustees, officers, directors, agents, representatives and employees, in both their personal and professional capacities (collectively also "KS"), for injuries, liabilities, losses or damages connected with or arising out of my child's participation in its trips and activities, or rendering of any medical treatment, to my/our child; and (b) I/We agree to indemnify, defend and forever hold harmless, KS from and against any and all claims, proceedings, injuries, liabilities, losses, damages, and expenses including reasonable attorneys' fees and cost, relating to my/our child's participation in the activity. I/We further agree to assume full responsibility for any injury or damage to my/our child or other person's or property that my/our child may cause arising out of or relating to my/our child's participation in the activity.

In case of injury or illness, we hereby give consent to authorize medical or dental treatment as deemed necessary.
